Program Description	BioQuest's specialized Site Explorations are the hallmark of SBRI's science education program. During the school day, a class of up to 32 students can visit BioQuest for an introduction to global health. Following a biosafety overview, students take an institute tour, learn from SBRI scientists about infectious disease research; and complete their day with a one-hour hands-on science activity in the BioQuest Learning Lab.
